Winter Stars is a unique and comprehensive summer dance program designed for dancers at beginning to intermediate levels who are passionate about performing or are new to the stage. This program couples technical dance classes for skill development with choreography classes to learn routines in corresponding styles. Winter Stars culminates in an exclusive performance opportunity in our Winter Stars Showcase this fall.

CAN COMPETITIVE DANCERS ALSO BE IN WINTER STARS?

Yes, our Team dancers are welcome to participate in the Winter Stars program as well. Some select competition team dances may also be included in the Winter Stars Showcase, but Team dancers wanting more performance opportunities are encouraged to participate.

WHAT IF MY CHILD HAS NEVER DANCED BEFORE?

This is a great opportunity for them to get their feet wet in the world of dance and performing arts! Winter Stars is designed for those at the beginner to intermediate levels, offering the necessary skills and building confidence for a successful stage performance.

WHAT IF WE ARE OUT OF TOWN FOR 1 OF THE 5 WEEKS?

Regular attendance is crucial for the success of any program, but we acknowledge that summer often involves family travel. In the event your dancer needs to miss a week, choreography rehearsals can be recorded for home review. If a dancer misses more than one week, a paid private lesson may be necessary.

WHEN ARE THE 3 ADDITIONAL REHEARSALS?

All performance choreography will be taught within the 5-week program. Monthly rehearsals will be scheduled in September and October, with an In-Studio Dress Rehearsal in November preceding the Showcase.

WHAT IS THE DATE OF THE SHOWCASE?
